## SECRETARY'S REPORT

I am honored to present the 35th Annual Report of the Society for the financial year 2023-24. This year, we saw significant financial improvements, reflecting our steadfast commitment to rural empowerment. Our Society's total revenue rose to ₹9.4 million from ₹2.7 million last year. Despite increased expenditures, we achieved a nominal surplus of ₹0.14 million, a remarkable turnaround from the previous year's ₹3.35 million deficit.







## **FINANCIALS**

₹ Millions

In the financial year 2023-24, we recorded a total revenue of ₹9.2 million, marking a significant increase from ₹2.7 million in the previous year. Despite increased expenditures, we maintained a nominal surplus of ₹0.14 million, a substantial improvement from the previous year's deficit of ₹3.35 million. #### **Evaluations and Studies**

Mandatory third-party verification of ODF Plus (Model) villages under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) Phase-II

The Program covered 419 villages across 10 districts in Andhra Pradesh. Commissioned by the Swachh Andhra Corporation, the program ran from February 2023 to June 2023. The impact of this initiative empowered District Administrations to take corrective actions and achieve the mission's objectives.

## **OUR WORK**

#### **Rural Entrepreneurship Development**

Establishment of a services marketplace as a social enterprise for Tier II and below cities, as well as rural areas in India.

The pilot will initially cover 30 villages within one district, either in Andhra Pradesh or Telangana, with plans to expand to all of India. This initiative is in partnership with First-Global Services and Technologies Private Limited and is set to run from September 2024 to March 2025. The program's impact focuses on promoting entrepreneurship and enhancing service accessibility in rural India.





## Nurturing Learning Environments

**WASH Initiative: Transforming Primary** 

**School Facilities** 

Empowering Futures: Building Rural

**School Infrastructure** 

The 'WASH Initiative' will enhance facilities for over 60 primary students, reducing the incidence of waterborne diseases, while 'Empowering Futures' will upgrade infrastructure for 300-400 higher secondary students. Both transformative projects are set for completion by June 2024, The former project is located in Siddipet Narsapur Village, District, Telangana, while the latter is in Pavalur Village, Bapatla District, Andhra Pradesh.



## **OUR WORK**

#### **Educational & Old Age Support**

Financial assistance for education and elderly care.

Educational assistance was provided to a girl child in Delhi, while support for elderly care was extended to a village in Nizamabad District, Telangana. These programs, funded by individual donations and supplemented by REEDS. During the financial year 2023-24, these initiatives enabled the academic progress of a young girl and brought joy and comfort to elderly residents at the orphanage.

#### **CSR** initiatives

Installation of Semi-Integrated Solar Street Lighting Systems and a Water Purifying Plant.

These programs, sponsored by NTPC covered two villages Peddapalli district, Telangana state. The Solar Street Lighting Systems reduced electricity bills for local authorities, improved nighttime safety and security, lowered the carbon footprint, boosted community pride and empowerment. The Water Purifying Plant reduced waterborne diseases, leading to significant health and economic benefits. It also provided reliable access to clean water, enhancing daily life, and further increased community pride empowerment.
