On 22 December 2025, in partnership with the Centre on Integrated Rural Development for Asia and the Pacific (CIRDAP), REEDS successfully hosted the India Regional Soft Launch of the CIRDAP-REEDS Rural Innovation Challenge Awards 2026. Anchored in the theme "*One Innovation. Endless Change. Countless Smiles.*.", this international challenge seeks to recognise, and amplify proven rural innovations that create tangible and transformative impact at the community levels. The gracious presence of eminent leaders and stakeholders from the rural development ecosystem added strong momentum—ensuring that this collective call for rural innovation resonates across Telangana, India, and beyond. Looking ahead, the Challenge will engage all 15 CIRDAP member countries across Asia and the Pacific, culminating in a published compendium of selected innovations and an international conference proposed in Sri Lanka in June 2026.

WASH: Inspiring a Generation

Through our WASH for Change initiative, REEDS continues to promote water, sanitation, and hygiene awareness among children in government schools—nurturing habits that last a lifetime. While the programme is currently paused, we remain optimistic and prepared to re-engage when conditions align. We
